What is the Jesse Tree?

The Jesse Tree is the genealogy, or family tree, of Jesus Christ... starting with Adam & Eve to Mary & Joseph.

How does the Jesse Tree work?

All you need is somewhere to place each daily ornament. Some people take all the needles off their Christmas tree to use year after year as a Jesse Tree, harkening back to the stump of Jesse. Other ideas, are to use a poster board to glue the ornaments onto, or to use removable tape, i.e. painters tape, to put the ornaments directly on a wall. Then, there is a short reading from the Bible each day. Also, join the Holy Heroes Guides in the daily Jesse Tree videos—available for FREE when you sign up for Advent Adventure or for purchase on DVD.

How does I know what ornaments to use?

Tuesday, December 3: Use the Day 3 ornament (Creation Part 2)
Wednesday, December 4: Use the Day 4 ornament (The Fall of Man)
Thursday, December 5: Use the Day 5 ornament (Noah)
Friday, December 6: Use the Day 6 ornament (Abraham)
Saturday, December 7: Use the Day 7 ornament (Isaac)
Sunday, December 8: Use the Day 8 ornament (Jacob) & light two purple candles on your Advent wreath
Monday, December 9: Use the Day 9 ornament (Joseph, Son of Jacob)
Tuesday, December 10: Use the Day 10 ornament (Moses)
Wednesday, December 11: Use the Day 11 ornament (Moses Part 2)
Thursday, December 12: Use the Day 11a ornament (Ruth)
Friday, December 13: Use the Day 12 ornament (Samuel)
Saturday, December 14: Use the Day 13 ornament (Jesse) & Day 14 ornament (David)
Sunday, December 15: Use the Day 15 ornament (Solomon) & light two purple candles and the rose candle on your Advent wreath
Monday, December 16: Use the Day 16 ornament (Elijah)
Tuesday, December 17: Use the Day 17 ornament (Elisha) & the O Wisdom Antiphon ornament
Wednesday, December 18: Use the Day 17a ornament (Isaiah's Prophecies), Day 18 ornament (Isaiah) & the O Lord of Lords Antiphon ornament
Thursday, December 19: Use the Day 18a ornament (Daniel), Day 19 ornament (Jeremiah) & the O Flower of Jesse's Stem
Friday, December 20: Use the Day 19a ornament (Angels), Day 20 ornament (Zechariah, Elizabeth & John the Baptist) & the O King of All Nations Antiphon ornament
Saturday, December 21: Use the Day 21 ornament (Blessed Virgin Mary) & the O Radiant Dawn Antiphon ornament
Sunday, December 22: Day 21a ornament (The Visitation), the O King of All Nations Antiphon ornament & light all four candles on your Advent wreath
Monday, December 23: Use the Day 22 ornament (Joseph) & the O Emmanuel Antiphon ornament
Tuesday, December 24: Use the Day 23 ornament (The Nativity) & the O Emmanuel Antiphon ornament
